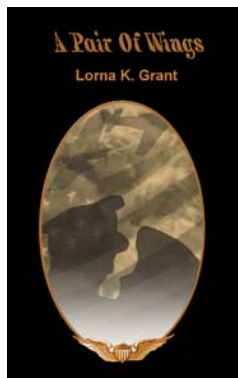
He wouldn't let her walk away...

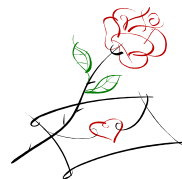
